## ARTIST STATEMENT

## Crazy Smooth

Street Dancer, Choreographer, Artistic Director

The inspiration for In My Body has literally been in my body for over a decade and realizing my vision in this large-scale format has been a transformational experience for me and my artistic collaborators. Aging affects every aspect of ourselves and the relationships we engage in. The essence of In My Body is found amongst the intergenerational cast, representatives of our broader community, from the elders on down to the up-and-coming generation of street dancers.

While audiences experience the show, they will notice themes common to their own experience of aging – from the youthful yearning to be "grown up", to the middle-aged realization that being grown up is not a fixed point, and the older generation's sage acceptance or stubborn defiance.

In My Body was created with the help of my people – my friends, my family, my tribe – through hours of conversation, deep dialogue, and love. In My Body is an homage to my community – a profound thank you from the stage.

## SHOW! IN DESCRIPTION

In My Body features an intergenerational group of nine dancers and an international creative team including original music by DJ Shash'U.

In My Body explores the multi-generational dynamic and the hardship and heroism of aging in street dancing. In keeping with hip-hop culture, b-boys/b-girls present a façade of confidence and invincibility as they engage in battles to prove their value and establish their dominance.

The resulting vocabulary is one of the most physically demanding and visually impressive of the dance genres and leaves no room for the expression of vulnerability.

In this layered investigation of street dancers' perseverance in the battle against time, In My Body goes deep into the culture of hip-hop through the eyes, minds and bodies of the multi-generational company. Writer Alejanrdo Rodriguez provides a powerful backdrop of personal stories of survival, triumph, and defeat drawn from interviews that he conducted with the dancers including DKC Freeze, the oldest dancer in the company (57, born 1965), and Tash (51, born in 1971).

The use of projection and lighting is alternately pulsating, soothing or absent, rendering each scene fresh and specific, while the transitions are so seamless the audience doesn't realize they have been moved


